SUMMER STUDENTSHIP

The New Zealand Medical Association provides an annual summer studentship worth \$4,000 to New Zealand medical students to complete a piece of research. Half the grant (\$2,000) will be paid at the outset and the remaining amount paid when the student's research report and supervisor's progress report are submitted to the NZMA. The duration is normally ten weeks over the summer break but greater or lesser times may be considered by negotiation.

For 2009/10, applications close Friday, 25 September 2009.

To apply for a studentship, medical students must submit a research plan (including timeline), in consultation with a supervisor, on a topic that is of relevance to the practice and profession of medicine. Together with their research plan, applicants must also complete the prescribed application form, submit a brief CV, and provide a minimum of one academic reference.

Applications will be assessed on:

1. Resonance with the goals of the NZMA
 - a. "to promote unity of the profession"
 - b. "to promote the health of New Zealanders"
2. Suitable supervision
3. Ability to complete in the required timeframe
4. Academic background
